Both models support flexible requirements to enable drivers to page another vehicle in the area/zone if new jobs are discovered. Or, drivers can receive pages from multiple dispatch operators if covering a wider zone of service.

Unobtrusive Design

The compact design and mounting flexibility of the VX-2100/2200 mobile radios make it easy to install anywhere in the cab for driver convenience.

Driver Safety

Built-in emergency alert capability enables a driver to press a button to send a distress alert to dispatch when help is needed.

If dispatch becomes concerned about the status of a taxi, the dispatch operator can activate remote listen of a specific car radio and hear what is going on in the cab. This useful feature is beneficial in the event of robberies or accidents when the driver is unable to respond.

Remote Management

To prevent unauthorized use if the VX-2100/2200 radio is ever lost or stolen, it can be immediately disabled. Use the Stun/Revoke commands to temporarily deactivate and reactivate the radio; or, use the Kill function to permanently disable the radio, which requires re-programming before using again.

Durability

The robust D-Sub 15 pin accessory connector minimizes the risk of third-party external devices being unplugged or accidentally ripped away from the radio.

Data Capability

VX-2100/2200 mobile radios include an external accessory connector port that allows for easy expansion of the radio's capability with external data devices.
